## GCCF Show Rules

- The Show is held under the Rules of the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy (GCCF).
- Exhibitors are recommended to read Section 4 of the GCCF Rules. A copy of the Rules may be purchased from the GCCF Office at 5 King's Castle Business Park, The Drove, Bridgwater, Somerset, TA6 4AG. Ignorance of the Rules will not be accepted as an excuse for a breach of the Rules.
- Free Show related leaflets may be obtained on request by sending a SAE to the GCCF Office. These leaflets are also available on the GCCF website at [www.gccfcats.org](http://www.gccfcats.org).
- Additional advice is available on the Club's website at [www.exotic-cat-club.org](http://www.exotic-cat-club.org).

## Club Show Rules

- Cats will be received at the entrance to the Show Hall on Saturday 7th April 2007 from 8.00 to 9.30 a.m.
- Cats shall be examined by a Veterinary Surgeon in accordance with the GCCF's Rule 7.
- If an exhibit is unable to be shown owing to illness, 50% of entry fees will be returned providing that a Veterinary Surgeon's certificate is received by the Show Manager seven days prior to the date of the Show.
- The Hall will be cleared of all but officials at 9.45 a.m. Judging will commence at 10.00 a.m. The Show will open to the public from 1.00 p.m. until 4.30 p.m.
- Exhibition pens only may be decorated or identified.
- Exhibits are received on condition that the Club shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to cats, boxes, baskets etc. or in any other way.
- The Committee, on behalf of the Club, retain their exclusive right to publish catalogues of their Shows containing information as to exhibits and names and addresses of exhibits and reserve to themselves the right to REFUSE ANY ENTRY WITHOUT GIVING A REASON.
- The Committee reserves the power to cancel or amalgamate any classes not already guaranteed. Announcements of any alteration in the Schedule will be made in 'Our Cats' publication and this shall be deemed sufficient notice.
- In the case of the Show being cancelled for any reason the Club reserves the right to retain a percentage of the fees to defray expenses.

## GENERAL GUIDELINES ON ENTERING SHOWS

- Where possible always complete the show entry form using the GCCF Registration or transfer certificate for the cat to be exhibited.
- **PRINT** details carefully to avoid misinterpretation in handwriting.
- If the Registration certificate is not available at the time of entry, complete the show entry form with the details from the pedigree, giving the first choice of name if it is a non-prefix registration, and enter **RAF** (Registration Applied For) or **TAF** (Transfer Applied For) or both in the Registered No. box.
- It is recommended that a stamped self-addressed acknowledgement postcard is enclosed with all registration or transfer applications, particularly for cats entered for shows, so that confirmation of application can be made by the GCCF.
- Keep a record of the completed entry form so that when registration details and numbers are received from the GCCF these details can be checked. The Show Manager requires to be notified in writing of the registration numbers together with any differences in any other details.

- If changes are notified to the Show Manager are not in time for printing in the Show Catalogue, the Show Manager will attached your notification to your entry form for reference. Show Managers are permitted to accept corrections at their own discretion, up to the close of the show on show day. However such a change must not be a change of exhibit.
- If several cats are being entered from the same household and the registered owners (exhibitors) differ within that family/household, check with the Show Manager whether using one entry form is acceptable or not. If one form is used indicate VERY CLEARLY which exhibitor owns which cat and ensure that ALL owners sign the entry form. If separate entry forms are used but joint owners of an exhibit(s) shall always use the same form and BOTH MUST SIGN.

## **DEFINITION OF CLASSES AND EXHIBITS**

(All definitions apply to shows held under GCCF Rules)

Open Classes:	Open to all of the specified breed.(must be GCCF Registered)
Cats:	Not less than 9 calendar months on the day of the show.
Kittens:	Not less than 14 weeks and under 9 calendar months on the day of the Show. Since 1/6/2001 neuter kittens are entered in kitten Open & Miscellaneous classes and compete for BIS Kitten. Neuter kittens of Preliminary Breeds should be included in Kitten Assessment classes where separate classes for Adult, Kitten and Neuter are scheduled.
Neuter Adults:	Neutered adults may only enter Neuter Classes and may not compete with entire cats or kittens except in Club Classes which are scheduled to include Neuters. Where Best in Show is held, the best Neuter shall be considered against the best Entire Adult and Kitten for Best Exhibit in Show.
Novice:	Exhibits that have not won a First Prize in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
Limit:	Exhibits that have not won more than four First Prizes in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
Debutante:	Exhibits that have never been shown at a show held under GCCF Rules.
Maiden:	Exhibits that have not won a First, Second or Third Prize in any class at a show held under GCCF Rules.
Breeders:	Exhibits bred by exhibitor/s. Cats originally registered in the Breeders' joint ownership but changed to single ownership of one of the Breeders can still be entered in this class. Cats originally registered in the Breeder's single ownership and changed to joint ownership with the Breeder should be entered in the Non-Breeders Class.
Adolescent:	Cats over 9 months of age and under 15 months on the day of the show.
Junior:	Cats over 9 calendar months of age and under 2 years on the day of the show.
Senior:	Cats 2 years old and over on the day of the show.
Aristocrat:	Exhibits that have won one or more Challenge/Premier Certificates but have not achieved Champion/Premier status.
Radius:	Exhibits that live within a 25 mile radius of the Show Hall
Visitors:	Exhibits that live over 25 miles from the Show Hall
Assessment:	For experimental breeds only. Entrants may also enter the appropriate Miscellaneous and Club Classes. Entries must include a Standard of Points which has been approved by the GCCF.

The status of the exhibit for entering restricted classes (i.e. Maiden, Limit, etc) shall be cats status on the day of entry, except where Section 2, Rule 15e applies. The wins as a Kitten do not count when the exhibit is shown as an Adult or Neuter; the wins as an Adult do not count when the exhibit is neutered and shown. Merit Awards do not count as 'wins' for entering restricted classes.

## ENTRY FEES

Fee includes benching fee, Open Class plus up to Three Miscellaneous or Club Classes and one admission pass. Charity Classes are not included in basic entry fee.

## **DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW HALL**

### **FROM THE M42**

Leave the M42 at J3 and follow the A435 (signposted Redditch & Evesham). Go through Mappleborough Green, Studley and past Coughton Court. At the roundabout take the second exit (to Alcester). Go past the Roebuck Inn on the left; at the traffic lights turn left into School Road. At the T junction turn left into Kinwarton Road, go over Gunnings Bridge and take the next left into Gunnings Road and immediately left into the Greig Centre.

### **FROM THE M40 (Warwick & Stratford on Avon)**

Leave the M40 at J15 taking the A46 South (signposted Stratford on Avon). The A46 will bypass Stratford. Follow signs to Alcester. At the roundabout take the A435 (signposted Birmingham & Redditch). At the next roundabout, take the third exit (signposted Alcester). At the Globe Island, exit for Coughton and Studley. At the traffic lights turn right into School Road. At the T junction turn left into Kinwarton Road, go over Gunnings Bridge and take the next left into Gunnings Road and immediately left into the Greig Centre.

### **FROM WORCESTER**

Take the A422, go through Inkberrow and follow the signs to Alcester. At the village of Arrow turn left at the T junction. At the roundabout take the exit for Alcester. At the Globe Island, exit for Coughton and Studley. At the traffic lights turn right into School Road. At the T junction turn left into Kinwarton Road, go over Gunnings Bridge and take the next left into Gunnings Road and immediately left into the Greig Centre.

### **FROM BRISTOL, THE SOUTHWEST AND EVESHAM**

Leave the M5 at J9 and follow the signs for Evesham and Stratford. Continue on the A46 to Alcester. At the roundabout take the exit for Alcester. At the Globe Island, exit for Coughton and Studley. At the traffic lights turn right into School Road. At the T junction turn left into Kinwarton Road, go over Gunnings Bridge and take the next left into Gunnings Road and immediately left into the Greig Centre.

### **PARKING**

There is clearly marked parking adjacent to the Greig Centre and also ample parking at the side and rear of the main Greig Hall.
